Mr. Thomas E. Harclerode, Mr. Ralph A. McCauley and Mr. Howard S. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Mrs. Mary F. Stahl was unanimously appointed Democrat Member of the Permanent Board of Registry.

It was decided that the Board will meet the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 1:30 P.M.

Date for open house for New Court House Annex will be held on June 29th from 3 P.M. till 9 P.M. and will give notice to the paper that we will be open for new registrations and transfers at that time. Members of the Board will be present at that time.

New Budget was explained to Board and letter from County Commissioners read explaining certain items. Raise of \$20 per month was granted to the office Clerks.

Mr. McCauley made motion to buy Five Large Binders, was seconded by Mr. Kaylor. Order will be given to Longs Business Equipment Co.,

Mr. McCauley reported that Surrey School would like to have the 3 Voting Machines moved from the School. Board suggested that we get prices on the moving of same.
