Under new business Mrs. Waters discussed that several people in the Pangborn Blvd. Section were put in the wrong voting district. Mr. Padula composed a letter to be sent to each person telling them we are changing them to their correct voting district.

It was announced the Part-Time Help will receive \$1.75 per hour, effective July 1, 1969.

Mr. McCauley read a letter from the County Commissioners approving the budget with a few exceptions.
