

February 11, 1964

The regular Monthly meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held at the office in the New Court House Annex at 3 P.M. on Feb. 11.

The following members were present:

Due to the absence of Mr. Harclerode, Chairman, Mr. Zombro presided over the meeting.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and minutes stand approved as read.

Reported Revised Lists of Demo. Poll-Workers had been given to Demo. Central Committee and Mr. Harclerode, Mr. Zombro will bring his list in for me to bring it up to date, in the near future. List of Poll Workers must be appointed not later than March 15th. I reported if there were many changes we would have to have a training school for them.

Discussed going into County Districts to register before Primary Election. Checked on past Records and found that in 1960 there was no County Registration made in the rural area before the Primary, but there was before the General Election. Mr. Bikle went on record as not favoring going out before the Primary. Mr. Zombro abstained from voting before he talked with Mr. Harclerode.

The procedure of completing the Absentee Ballots will be further discussed at our next meeting. Board went on Record as recommending letting voters complete their own applications.

The Board OK'd Bills for Mrs. Myers & Mrs. Corbett, for 7 days work.

Discussed the following voting places being overcrowded on Election Day, as follows:

Halfway- Dist # 26  
Ant. St. School " # 17-1  
So. Potomac Jr. Hi. Dist 17-2 & 17-3  
Woodland Way School Dist 21-3  
No decision was made regarding them.

The New Voting Machine covers will be distributed when machines are readied by the Custodians for the Presidential Primaries.

The Democrat Central Committee requested the privilege of having someone come in & recheck their card files with the Permanent Registration Record Book. Board fully agreed it was permissible for each political party to do so.
