President Tammy Downin called the meeting to order at 4:02pm at the Washington County Election Center, 17718 Virginia Avenue, Hagerstown, MD 21740.

Declaration of Quorum Present:

 - a) Highlights from August 21, 2025 meeting:
 - (1) DOJ and SBE have been corresponding about a DOJ request for Maryland's voter registration list. SBE is working with the Attorney General's office on a response.
 - (2) The President's Executive Order is at a standstill, due to injunction by several states. Rumors of a second Executive Order on mail in voting.
 - (3) There is discussion about passing laws regarding congressional redistricting.
 - (4) There was a lengthy discussion about the new SBE approved election judge application form. All 24 jurisdictions agreed that it is inadequate in its current form and must be modified. SBE asked MAEO to come up with their version, and they would work together to resolve it.

H. Early Voting Sites for 2026

COMAR 33.17.02.02 and Senate Bill 259 were distributed to the board. Barry Jackson explained how each site either met specific criteria of the law, or it did not satisfy the law. Discussion ensued regarding the weighted criteria that the law states need to be considered regarding the selection of early voting sites. Brian Kane suggested calculating a score for each early voting site and comparing the scores with the law to see which locations are best suited to be considered as an early voting site.

Barry Jackson introduced the election plan to the board so that the board can approve the plan at the October 14 board meeting. Polling places and ballot drop boxes remain unchanged from the 2024 election.
