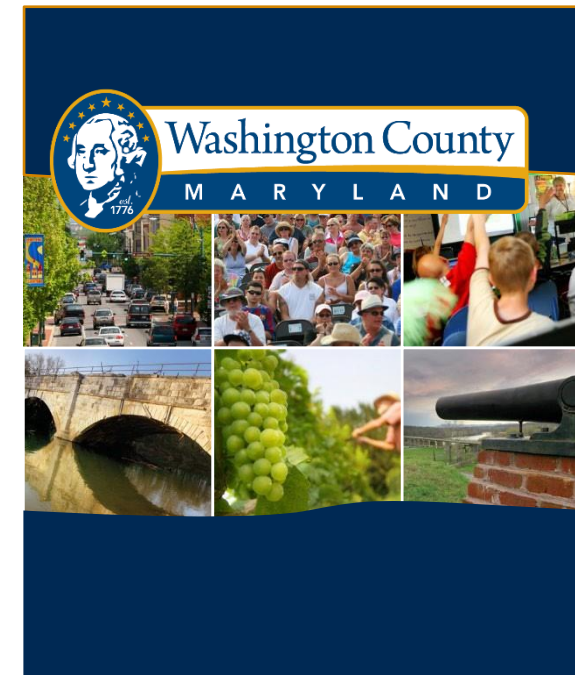
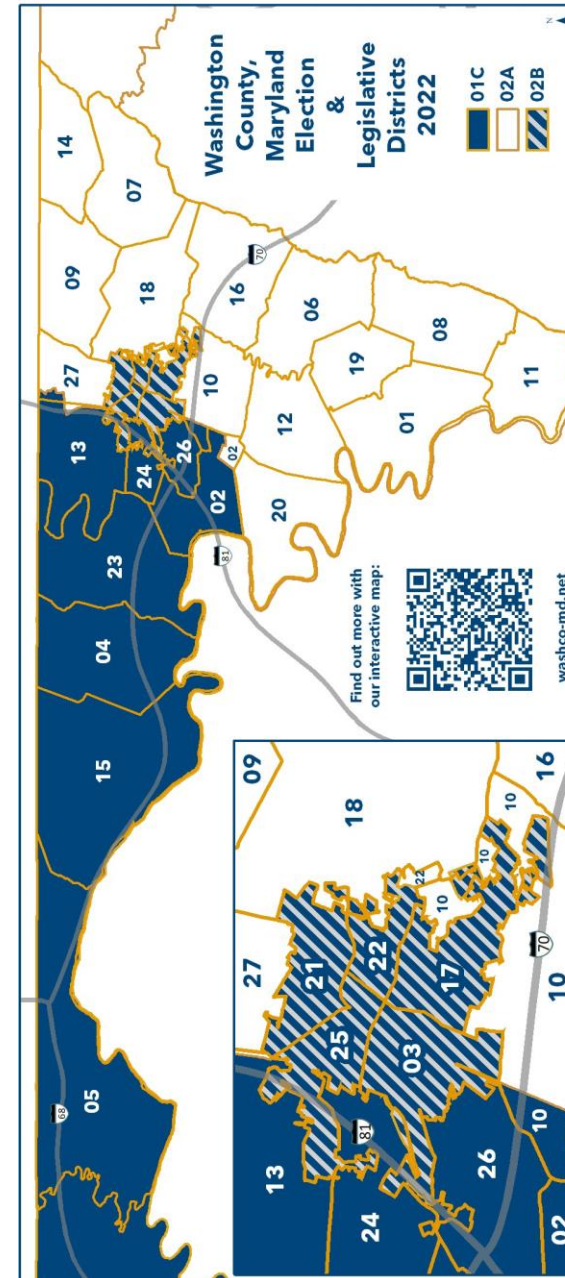

Citizens' Guide to Washington County Government 2023 – 2024

Facts for Voters

To register, you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen;
- Be a Maryland resident;
- Be at least 16 years old;*
- Not be under guardianship for mental disability or if you are, you have not been found by a court to be unable to communicate a desire to vote;
- Not have been convicted of buying or selling votes;
- Not have been convicted of a felony, or if you have, you have completed serving a court-ordered sentence of imprisonment.

❖ You may register to vote if you are at least 16 years old but cannot vote unless you will be at least 18 years old by the next general election.

How to Register:

- By mail, online or in person at the Board of Elections or call 240.313.2050 for an application.
- Pick up an application at any post office, school, State agency or Motor Vehicle Administration when you apply for a driver's license, picture ID, change your address or change your name on your driver's license.
- First time voters in Maryland must provide their current Maryland driver's license or state ID number; if they do not have a driver's license, then and only then, the last four digits of their Social Security number for verification of identity.
- An application may be downloaded from the State website at www.elections.maryland.gov. Mail the completed form to the Board of Elections.
- You must register with a party if you want to take part in that party's primary election, caucus or convention.

Election Judge Recruitment

Election Judges must:

- Must be a registered voter in Maryland
- Must be at least 16 years of age (under 18 requires Parental Consent Form)
- Be able to speak, read, and write the English Language
- Be physically and mentally able to work a 15-hour day
- Have your own transportation
- Election judges are paid based on the position that you work
